

Authors' Instructions for ICCES'07: Sample Pages

Summary

This document summarizes the authors' instructions for ICCES'07. Manuscripts are limited to 6 pages and we request that all authors adhere to the instructions to ensure that the style of the publication is consistent. This short document can be viewed as a sample paper and will assist authors in manuscript preparation.

Introduction

The text should be placed in an area that is 5 in (127 mm) in width and 7.5 in (195.5 mm) in height. Manuscripts with text areas significantly larger than this will not be accepted for inclusion in the conference proceedings.

To submit an electronic copy of the manuscript, please convert the document into the PDF format. Due to portability problems, electronic versions in formats other than PDF will *not be accepted*. Also, PDF documents that can not be viewed by an English version of Acrobat Reader will not be accepted.

Use Times New Roman 11 point size, single spacing, except for the heading as outlined below. Use new roman type throughout, except for some mathematics symbols etc. Even justification should be used for the text in all paragraphs.

Please be careful to ensure that the text in figures and tables are not too small.

Text Layout

The title of the paper should be typed in bold, Times 13 point size at the top of the document as illustrated. This should be followed by all the authors. The affiliations and contact addresses of the authors should be typesetted as footnotes to the name of the authors. The title and the authors should be centered in the document.

All section headings should be in bold and should be centered in the document. Sections should not be numbered and there should be no sub-sections. The first section should be labeled **Summary** and should contain a brief description of the contents of the paper. One blank line should be left above and below all section headings and one blank line should be left between all paragraphs. If a section heading falls at the bottom of a page, then that heading should be moved to the top of the next page.

The first line of all paragraphs should be indented by 0.25 in (6mm).

Equations should be indented 0.25in (6 mm) from the left margin of the page. These

equations should be numbered consecutively with one blank line above and below all equations.

$$E = mc^2 \tag{1}$$

Figures (diagrams and photographs) should also be numbered consecutively and should be placed in the text soon after the point where they are referenced. Figures should be centered in the manuscript and should have a figure caption placed underneath. The figures may be pasted in or, in the case of diagrams, they may be printed from a file. Again, one blank line should be placed above and below all figures. Photographs should be black and white originals and should be of good quality and should not be photocopied.

Tables should also be numbered consecutively and should be placed in the text soon after the point where they are referenced. Tables should be centered in the manuscript and should have a table caption placed above. The tables may be pasted in or they may be printed from a file. Again, one blank line should be placed above and below all tables.

In the text, references [1] are indicated by a number in square brackets [2]. The reference section that follows in this sample document illustrates the format that should be used. Journal and book titles should be in *italic*.
